Topical Issue on "Plasma processing for nanostructured materials and interfaces"

Instructions for authors

Selected papers from the 16th International Conference on Plasma Physics and Applications which covers the subjects in the field of "Plasma processing for nanostructured materials and interfaces" will be included in a Topical Issue of the Digest Journal of Nanomaterials and Biostructures (open access, ISI impact factor in 2013 of 1.092), upon regular refereeing process.

Highly interdisciplinary papers in the field of plasma processing, condensed matter (anorganic and organic) including nanomaterials and those focusing on the environmental and biomedical applications are welcomed.

Please note that maximum two papers can be submitted for publication per one registered participant.

The manuscript must be written in British English, as Word document (extension *.doc or *.docx), using Times New Roman fonts, 12 points, with 1.5 line spacing, on A4 paper size with margins of 2.5 cm an all sides. Review papers are limited to 25 pages. Regular papers are limited to 12 pages, while short communications are limited to 6 pages. Every manuscript must have an abstract with maximum 200 words. Figures and Tables with their caption should be introduced in the text, on the appropriate position.

The following structure of the paper is highly recommended:

- 1. Abstract,
- 2. Keywords,
- 3. Introduction,
- 4. Experimental (Theory, Modelling),
- 5. Results,
- 6. Discussion,
- 7. Conclusions,
- 8. References.

Please use the following style for references:

The submissions should be accompanied by a separate file, signed by the corresponding author, which will include the answers to the following:

- 1. Does the present submission represent original work?
- 2. Is the present work being considered for publication elsewhere in any other form?
- 3. Is some part of the present work published elsewhere? If so, provide details.
- 4. Are all co-authors aware of this submission?
- 5. Have all co-authors contributed to this work?

Signature

Any manuscript which does not have this statement letter will be automatically rejected.

Manuscripts should be uploaded via the Easychair conference website (<u>www.easychair.org</u>), providing in the category section the journal which fits better the work.

The **Paper file** should be in *.doc or *.docx format and should contain the whole manuscript.

The **Attachment file** should contain in a single *.pdf file the following information:

- a) a cover letter associated to the submission;
- b) the manuscript, including the title, authors and affiliation, abstract, manuscript body with tables and figures included;
- c) statement letter containing the answers to the questions mentioned above.

In cases of uploading failing, we can accept, as well, papers submitted via e-mail to: cppa2013@infim.ro; such subsmissions should contain the same files as those uploaded via the Easychair conference website.

Submissions will undergo a review process identical to that of regular papers submitted to DJNB journal, namely every manuscript will be sent to at least two referees for a critical examination.

The reports of the referees and the Decision of the Editors regarding the publication will be sent to the corresponding authors.

All the accepted manuscripts will be published in the dedicated topical issue of DJNB. A copyright transfer statement will be requested to the authors prior the publication in the journal.

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
